

Subject: Submittal of the Supplemental Interim Measure Report for Solid Waste Management Unit 01-001(f)

Dear Mr. Bearzi:

Enclosed please find two hard copies with electronic files of the Supplemental Interim Measure Report for Solid Waste Management Unit 01-001(f). This document is being submitted in response to the New Mexico Environment Department's (NMED's) March 8, 2010, letter approving the extension request for removal of polychlorinated biphenyl- (PCB-) contaminated soils in the drainage below Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 01-001(f).

The enclosed supplemental interim measure (IM) report also responds to NMED's August 25, 2010, letter providing comments on the IM report for SWMU 01-001(f) that was submitted to NMED on May 3, 2010. This letter directs Los Alamos National Security, LLC, and the U.S. Department of Energy to address comments in the supplemental IM report rather than to revise the May 2010 report. All comments have been incorporated into the supplemental IM report.

The title of the May 2010 IMR included reference to site monitoring area (SMA) LA-SMA-2. Reference to LA-SMA-2 has been removed from the title of the supplemental IM report because LA-SMA-2, which was included in the Federal Facility Compliance Agreement (FFCA) to monitor stormwater discharges from SWMU 01-001(f), is not included in the individual National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit that has replaced the FFCA. Under the individual NPDES permit, stormwater discharges from SWMU 01-001(f) are monitored at LA-SMA-2.1, which is at a different physical location than LA-SMA-2. To avoid confusion between these SMAs, the supplemental IM report title now refers only to SWMU 01-001(f). Because the locations of both LA-SMA-2 and LA-SMA-2.1 are in the drainage below SWMU 01-001(f), reference to the SMA in addition to SWMU 01-001(f) is not necessary to define the project area.


