



Public Notice – Class 1 Permit Modifications to the Los Alamos National Laboratory Hazardous Waste Facility Permit

**Removal of Structures from Technical Area (TA) 63
Removal of the Burn Unit at TA-16-399 and Updates to the Part A Application
Removal of Permit Conditions for TA-54-38 West Outdoor Pad**

The Department of Energy (DOE) and Triad National Security, LLC (Triad) performed three Class 1 permit actions to the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (the Permit).

- The Permittees submitted a Class 1 permit modification request (PMR) for the removal of a Real-time Radiography trailer that was never used, removal of a characterization trailer that was never placed at the site, updates to the unit description, the associated closure plan, and a location figure at TA-63. The request was submitted December 23, 2024, in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 40 (40 CFR), 270.42(a)(1) and Permit Section 3.1(3). The New Mexico Environment Department-Hazardous Waste Bureau (NMED-HWB) approved this modification on February 6, 2025.
- The Permittees submitted a Class 1 PMR to remove Permit conditions for the TA-16-399 Burn Tray from the Permit to complete clean closure. The modification was transmitted to the NMED-HWB on February 28, 2025. The request also included updates to the Part A Application. The request was submitted in accordance with 40 CFR 270.42(a)(2). The NMED-HWB approved this modification on April 3, 2025.
- The Permittees submitted a Class 1 PMR to remove Permit conditions that are no longer applicable to the TA-54-38 West Outdoor Pad through updates to Attachment A, Section A.4.3., TA-54 West. The modification was transmitted to the NMED-HWB on February 28, 2025. The request was submitted in accordance with 40 CFR 270.42(a)(2). The NMED-HWB approved this modification on April 15, 2025.
