Dear Theodore Wyka, Jessica Kunkle, Steven Coleman, and Bradley Smith:

On October 6, 2025, Department of Energy (DOE), Triad National Security, LLC (Triad), and Newport News Nuclear BWXT-Los Alamos, LLC (N3B), (collectively referred to as the Permittees) submitted an *Intent to Appeal September 9, 2025, Fee Assessment Los Alamos National Laboratory* (Intent to Appeal) as referenced by ALDESHQ-25-050.

NMED has reviewed the Intent to Appeal and concurs that counts for storage in containers (S01) is 26, Storage in Tanks (S02) is 1, Treatment units (T04) are 20, Subpart X units (X01) are 3, Land Disposal units (D80) are 3, and Corrective Action Section unit (Other) is 1.

However, NMED does not concur that there are no additional SWMUs/AOCs since new SWMUs/AOCs have been added after the last permit renewal.

In accordance with 20.4.1.900 NMAC, incorporating 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 270, NMED has determined that the Permit Renewal Application is administratively complete. NMED will start the technical review of the Permit Renewal Application once the fee has been received.

NMED has accepted the Permit Renewal Application for review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee regulations, 20.4.2.201.F NMAC, requires the assessment of fees. The revised fee invoice is attached to this letter.

Payment is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice in accordance with 20.4.2.301.C NMAC. If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Vanessa Baros, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds. If you disagree with the assessed fee, you may notify NMED in writing at the address below with the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.
