The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy, National Nuclear Security Administration, Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA) and Triad National Security, LLC (Triad) *Technical Area 63 Transuranic Waste Facility Soil Vapor Monitoring System Report, Calendar Year 2026, Quarter 1* (Report) dated and received on March 27, 2026, and as referenced by LA-UR-26-22325/EPC-DO-26-058.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Vanessa Baros, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds.
