**Comment. Table C-2 Pajarito Analytical Results, page C-133:**


The Report indicates a detection of chloromethane at 0.39 µg/L in the sample collected from well R-19, Port 232 on June 2, 2010. The detection is indicated as "EQB" in the Field QC Type column. The acronym EQB is not explained in the list of symbols, abbreviations and acronyms used in Appendix C. The Permittees must describe all

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symbols, abbreviations and acronyms used in future reports.
