Dear Messrs. Rael and Graham:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security L.L.C.'s (LANS) (collectively, the Permittees) *Request to Reduce the Frequency of Vapor Sampling at Material Disposal Area T* (Request), dated November 1, 2011 and referenced by EP2011-0356.

The Permittees state that the data collected to date are sufficient to prepare the Corrective Measures Evaluation for Material Disposal Area (MDA) T. NMED will evaluate the next phase of corrective action based on the data accumulated to date. NMED hereby grants the request to discontinue quarterly vapor sampling at MDA T.

In the Request, the Permittees propose to sample the current approved sampling ports at MDA T on an annual basis. In accordance with Governor Martinez' policy to prioritize groundwater and surface water protection, NMED directs the Permittees to discontinue all vapor sampling at MDA T and to divert those limited resources earmarked for annual vapor sampling at MDA T to the site wide groundwater monitoring program. NMED will address further vapor monitoring activities at MDA T at the implementation phase for the selected remedy.

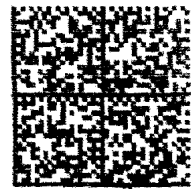
