The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS) (collectively, the Permittees) *Inspection and Maintenance of Erosion Controls in the Drainages to the 90s Line Pond at Technical Area 16*, dated November 29, 2011 and referenced by EP2011-0405. The Permittees were directed to conduct annual inspections and submit proof of maintenance of the erosion controls in the drainages to the 90s Line Pond to NMED (December 31, 2008).

An inspection of the erosion controls in the drainages to the 90s Line Pond was conducted in November 2011 and it was discovered that two of the four juniper bale check dams were damaged. The check dams were repaired and are now reported to be in good operating condition. The Permittees submitted documentation indicating that erosion controls are being maintained. Messrs. The Permittees must continue to inspect, maintain, and repair the erosion controls, as needed, to reduce sediment transport to the 90s Line Pond. An annual report documenting the proof of maintenance of erosion controls for 2012 must be submitted no later than **November 30, 2012**, and annually by November 30th of every year thereafter.
