Dear Messrs. Turner and Grieggs:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS) (collectively, the Permittees) *Demolition Notification for Quarter Ending September 30, 2013* Dated June 26, 2013, and referenced by WM-DO-13-0013/LA-UR 13-24307.

As stated by the Permittees, the investigations are not complete at several Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and Areas of Concern (AOCs) located within 50 feet of the buildings proposed for demolition. Several of these SWMUs and AOCs are either scheduled or may be proposed for further investigation. The Permittees state that they shall ensure that the sampling locations and depths proposed in the approved work plans are not affected by these activities. In the case of adverse

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

impacts on the SWMUs/AOCs where investigations are not complete, the Permittees must document all demolition activities in detail so that any impacts on the SWMUs/AOCs can be identified and evaluated.

The Permittees must provide a copy of the demolition reports, if prepared, to NMED within 30 days after the reports are completed in accordance with Section 1.17.3 of the Permit.


